

Performance for Stage and Screen

All Levels

We are looking forward to meeting you at your interview for the Performance for Stage and Screen course here at SGS, Stroud Campus.

In order to support you being placed on the best level of course for you, you will be required to prepare one of the following as an audition piece:

- A monologue of your choice (minimum 1.5 minutes)
- A song of your choice either without music or bring a backing track. (please note, a piano will not be available to accompany you on the day)
- A dance/ movement performance either without music or bring a backing track (minimum 1.5 minutes)

Select something to showcase your strongest abilities within the field of performance; something that will make you stand out and be remembered.

On your audition day you will attend a 30 minute group workshop in which you will be required to work with other auditionees, before then showing your monologue privately to an interview panel.

Please dress appropriately for movement based work, there are spaces for you to change close to the interview room. Ensure you have rehearsed and warmed up sufficiently in order to show your best agility and ability in your audition.
