Please report to Reception on arrival

You must attend an interview to secure a place on your chosen study programme

Prior to Interview/What to bring with you

- Please come dressed in all **black clothing**
- Please bring **achieved and/or predicted grades** – A final conditional offer will be made based on predicted grades and the result of your interview.
- You need to prepare a **handwritten document** answering the following questions:
 - What are you doing at the moment (at school, work etc)? What do you enjoy about it?
 - Why would you like to study your chosen subject area?
 - What would you like to do after you complete your study programme at SGS?
 - What career path do you intend to follow?
 - What sort of personal interests do you have?
 - How do you think a Hairdresser/Beauty Therapist/Make-Up Artist should present themselves in the salon or studio?
- Prepare a **mood/inspiration board** (more details below)
- Arrange for a **model** to come with you to apply your make-up on (more details below)

Interview Structure

- A **group presentation** about the college and more specifically the Media Make-Up Department
- Finally, you will participate in a **Group Skills Test**. This is a fantastic opportunity to get to know your potential peers and meet our staff

Skills Test Information

The Interview/Skills Test Event will last 90 minutes and applicants will be taken for their 1:1 interview during this time

Your **Skills Test** will be held in the Make-Up Artistry room at the same time as other applicants. During this time, the tutor may ask you informal questions about your make-up application and products. You will spend around 45 minutes of make-up application based on the theme of **Fairy Tales**.

You will need to bring your own model and the tools/products you need for the make-up application. Prior to the skills test you should have prepared a Mood/Inspiration Board to show the planning of your desired look and what you are aiming for. This could also include photos of your practice.

You will have the opportunity to ask any questions during your interview to help you feel fully prepared for your start in September 2019.

We run regular interviews and spaces are limited. If you cannot attend your appointment for any reason, please contact our **Admissions Department** on **01453 761165**, who will be able to arrange another date/time for you. Please note if you miss multiple interview dates, this may have a negative impact on your application.

Should you at any time decide not to take up your place on the course, we would be pleased if you would let us know so that we can offer the place to another applicant if needed.
